

- 1.2-8 The positive value of trials
- **1.9-11 -** Humility over hubris
- 1.12-15 The blessings of temptation
- 1.16-18 God's good gifts generously graces us
- 1.19-20 Graced by God: we must be patient as God is patient
- 1.21 Graced by God: in concert with & saved by his will/word, we avoid sin
- 1.22-25 Graced by God: we not only hear God's word, we obey it
- 1.26-27 Graced by God: we must not only think right, we must act right



James 1 - Detailed Outline

- **1.1**
 - Author, James
 - James, in NT (lakobos), a form of OT "Jacob"

 - brother of Jesus Mk 6.3, Lk 6.16
 - literal brother/half-brother of Jesus (son of Mary/Joseph)
 - step-brother of Jesus (son of Joseph but not Mary)
 - some other relative of Jesus

 son of Zebedee Mk 1.16ff
son of Alphaeus Mt 10.3
tax collector Mk 2.14 son of Mary, not an apostle Mt 27.56
father of Judas, not Iscariot Lk 6.16

 - Author, James
 - Jesus' brothers did not initially believe in him Jn 7.5


 - James was ...

 - identified as a key "leader" in the early church Acts 12.17
 - Played a key role in the Jerusalem meeting Acts 15.1ff

Jesus' brothers were part of the apostles' group after resurrection Acts 1.14

 a witness of the resurrected Messiah 1 Cor 15.7
brother of Jude Jude 1.1 Paul's mention of him was consistent with that role Acts 21.18, Gal 1.19, 2.1ff

 - Identified as ...
 - A "bondservant of God" ...
 - "And of the Lord Jesus Christ"
 - Bondservant/slave ($\delta o \upsilon \lambda o \sigma$)
 - 20.27, Mk 10.44, Rom 1.1, 2 Pet 1.1, Jude 1

Usually used in a positive sense of those totally devoted to the Lord Mt

Often used with reference to the apostles
Freq noted first before apostleship

 - Diaspora/dispersion cf. Jn 7.35, Acts 15.23
 - pilgrim cf Acts 2.9-11, I Pet 1.1
 - Gen 11.8-9

 Negatively: Applied to the Jews after Assyrian/Babylonian captivities (for their lack of faith) • Positively: Referred to their return Deut 30.3, Jer 31, Ez 37

• OT Jewish dispersion prophesied by Moses Lev 26.33, Deut 4.27, 28.64, cf.

Refers to someone living in country not their own (ie., stranger, foreigner,
