



### Marriage of Female Heirs

**36** Now the chief fathers of the families of the children of Gilead the son of Machir, the son of Manasseh, of the families of the sons of Joseph, came near and spoke before Moses

and their inheritance remained in the tribe of their father's family.

**13** These are the commandments and the judgments which the LORD commanded the children of Israel by the hand of Moses in the plains of Moab by the Jordan, across from Jericho.

## The Fifth Book of Moses Called **DEUTERONOMY**

### The Previous Command to Enter Canaan

**1** These are the words which Moses spoke to all Israel on this side of the Jordan in the wilderness, in the plain<sup>a</sup> opposite Suph,<sup>b</sup> between Paran, Tophel, Laban, Hazeroth, and Dizahab.

**2** It is eleven days' journey from Horeb by way of Mount Seir to Kadesh Barnea.

**3** Now it came to pass in the fortieth year, in the eleventh month, on the first day of the month, that Moses spoke to the children of Is-

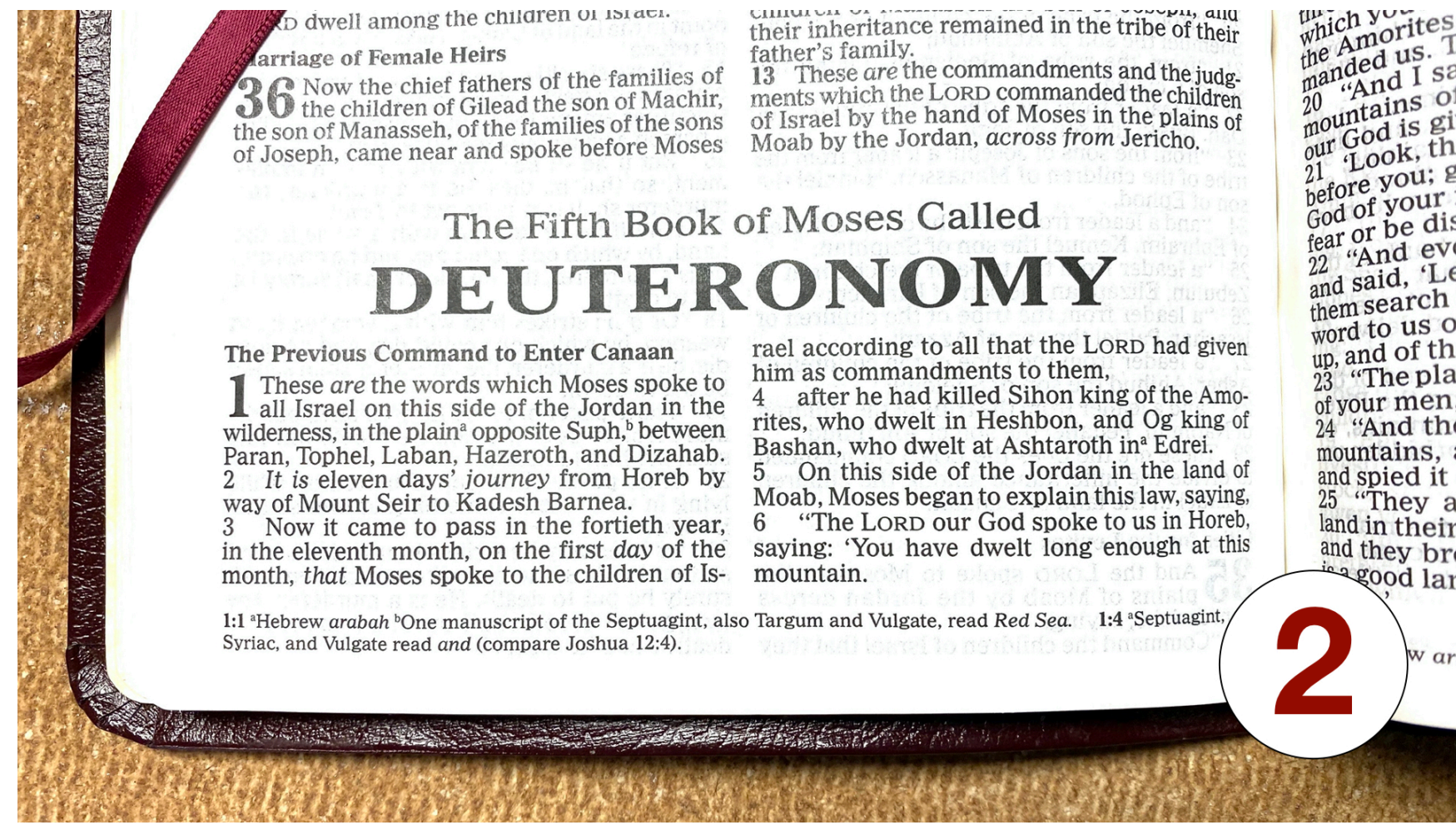
rael according to all that the LORD had given him as commandments to them,

**4** after he had killed Sihon king of the Amorites, who dwelt in Heshbon, and Og king of Bashan, who dwelt at Ashtaroth in<sup>a</sup> Edrei.

**5** On this side of the Jordan in the land of Moab, Moses began to explain this law, saying,

**6** "The LORD our God spoke to us in Horeb, saying: 'You have dwelt long enough at this mountain.

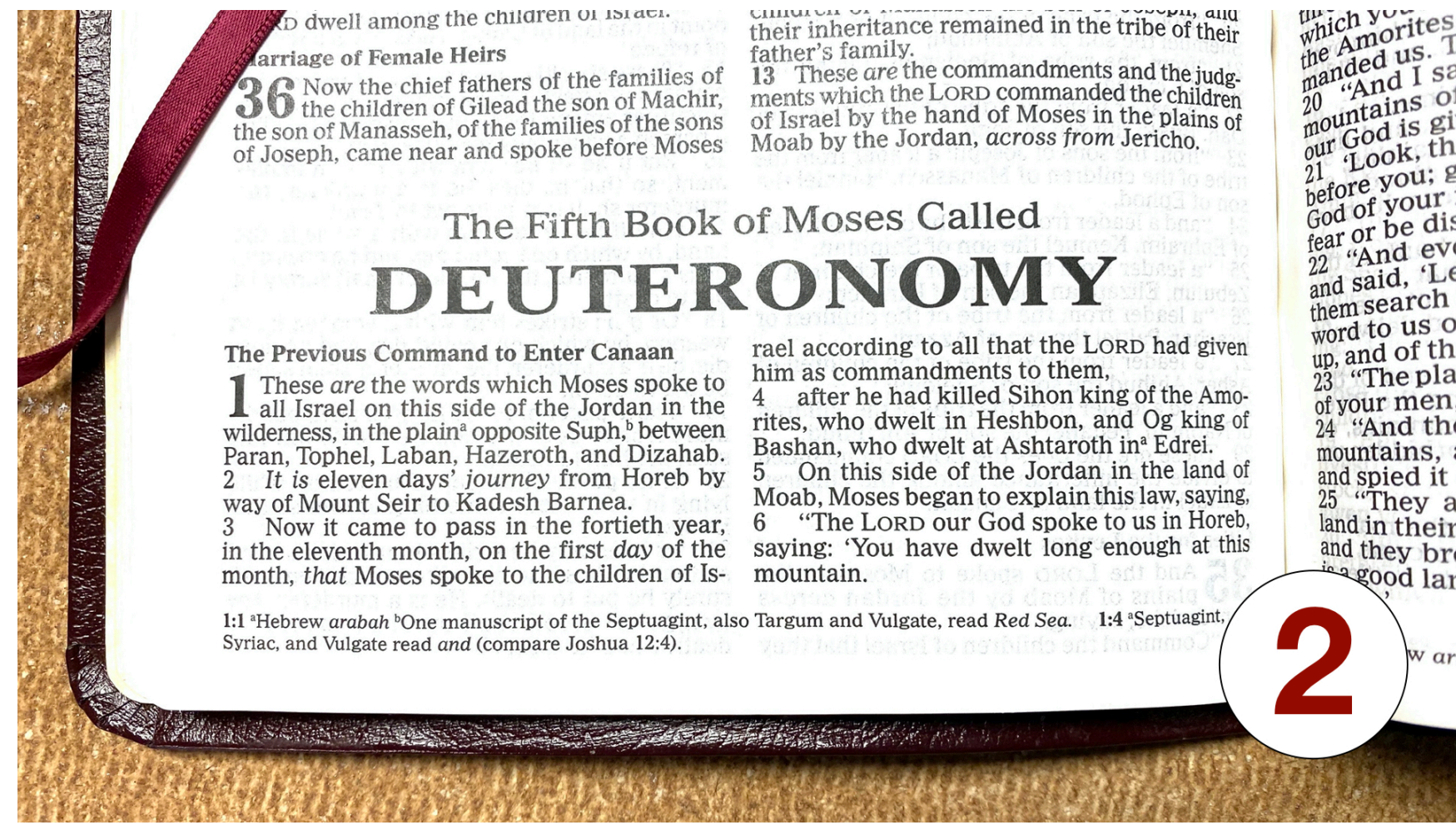

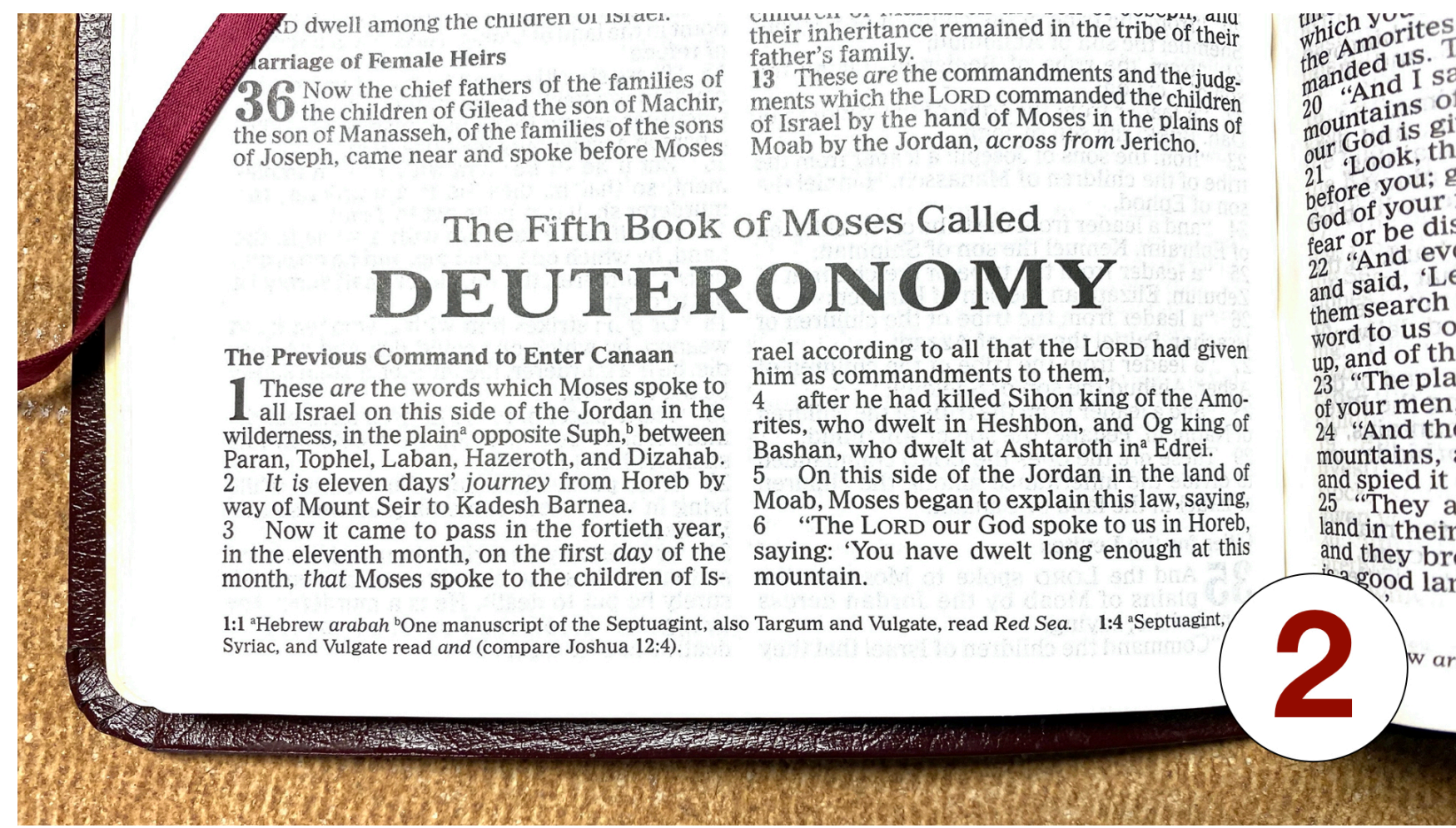

- **What God **was** • What God **is** • What God **will be** (Ex 3.14-15, Neh 9.7-8)**

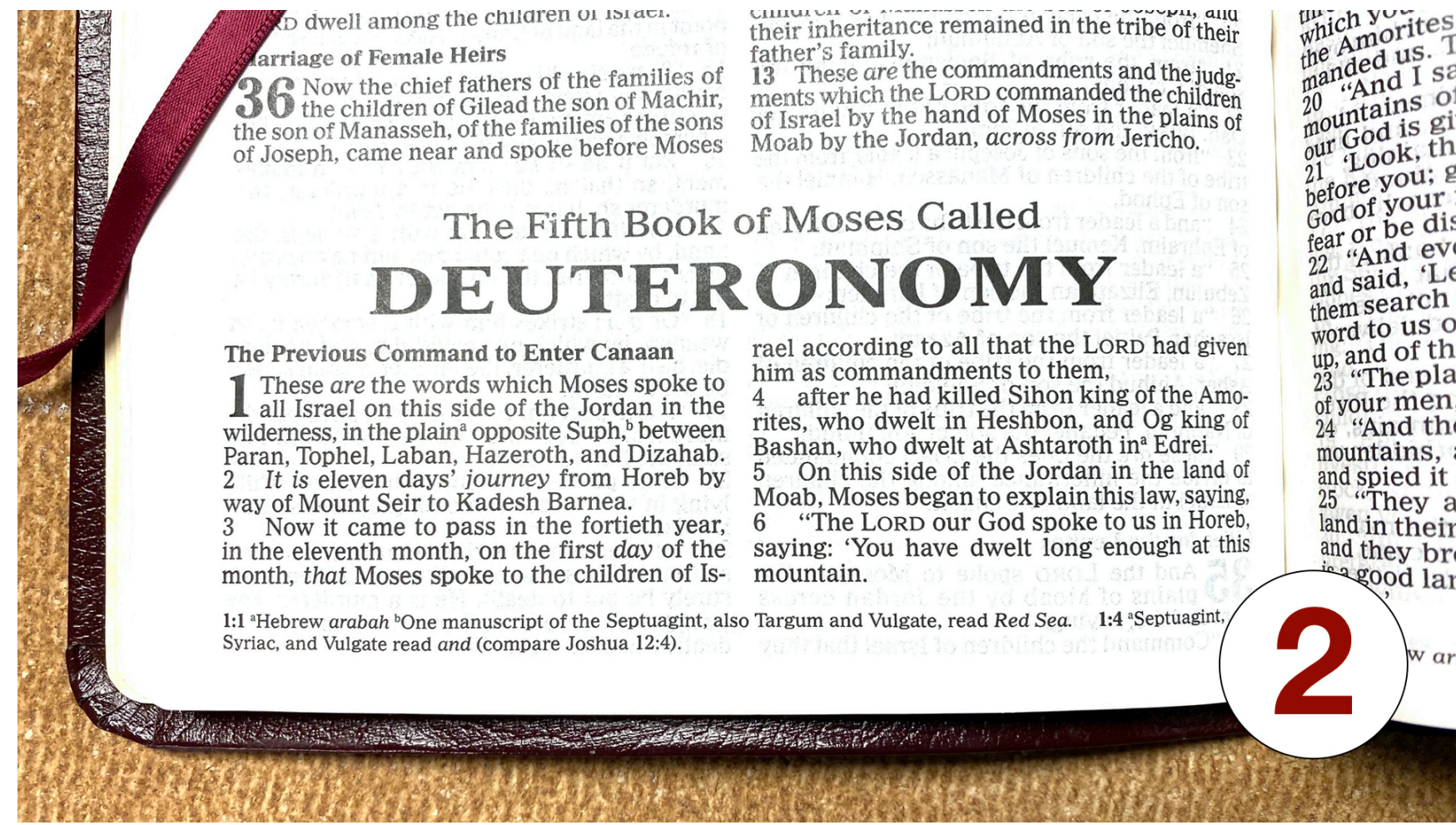
- **What God **thought** • What God **thinks** • What God **will think** (Num 23.19ff)**

- **What **does** change ...**

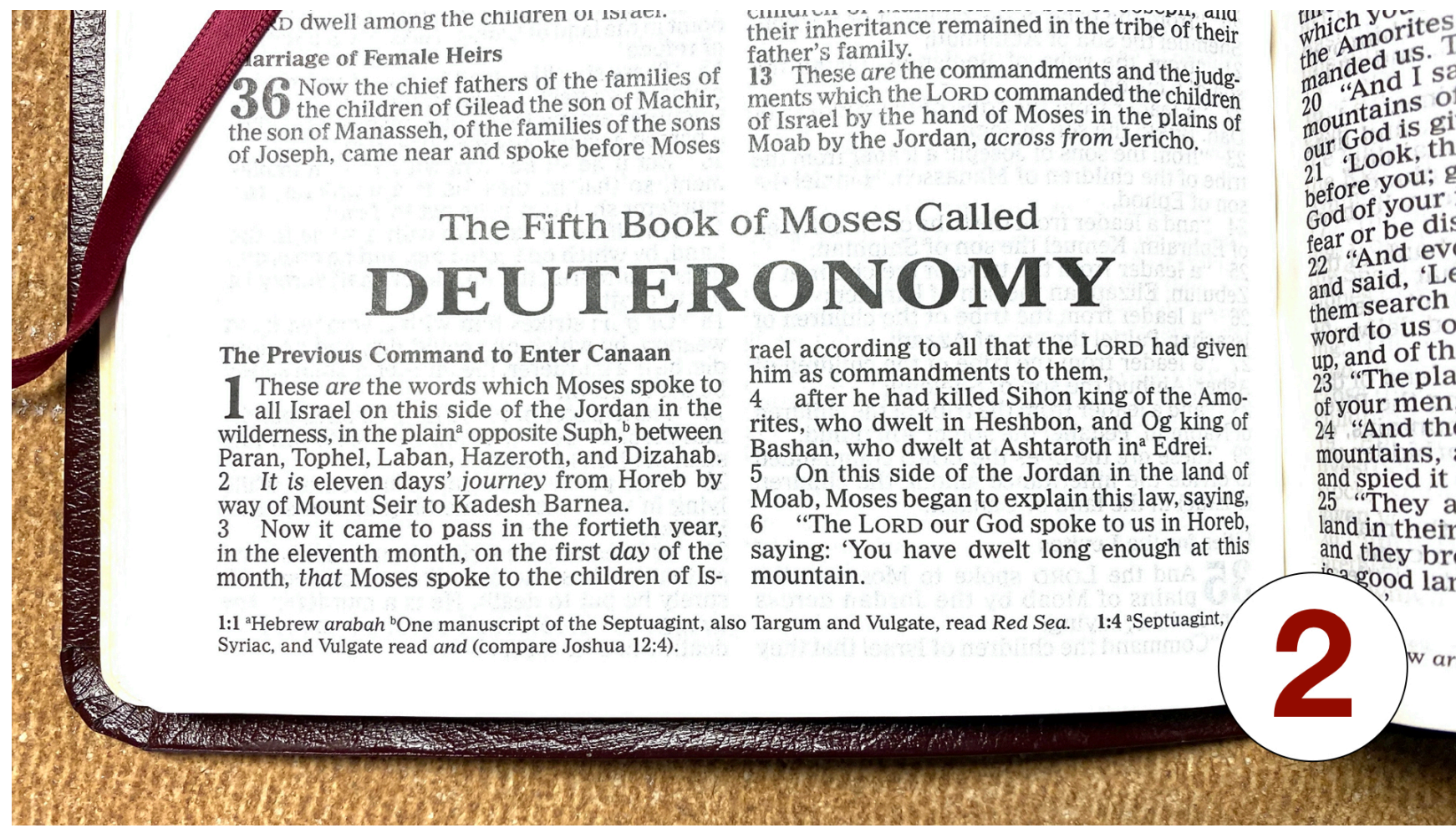
- **People • Circumstances/Contexts • Prophecies/Fulfillments**

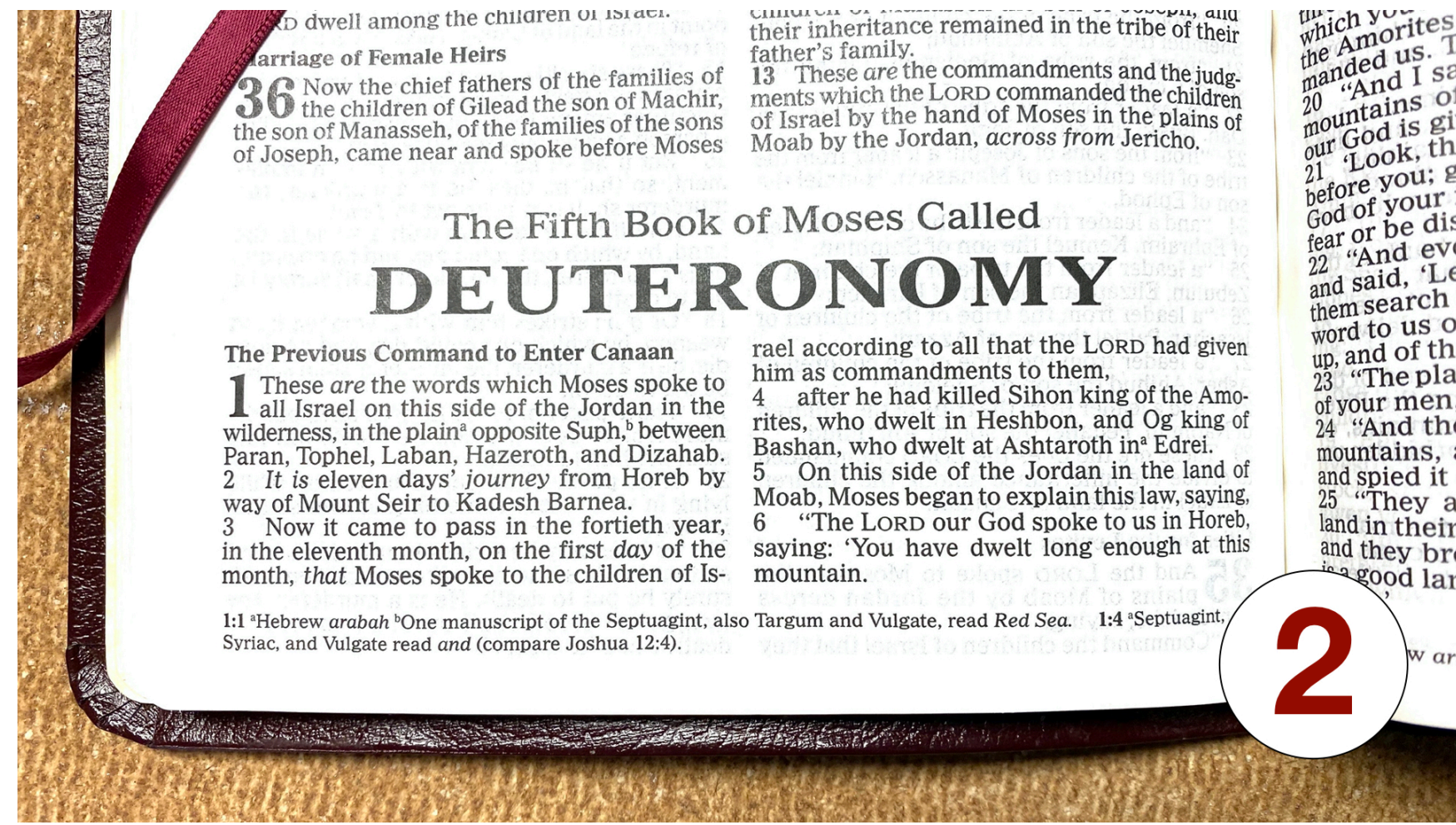

# Lessons From Deuteronomy

---

- **Key Messages - 2 • One God/Godhead (6.4)**
  - **One Father • One Son • One Spirit**
    - **Identical characteristics/attributes**
    - **Identical and co-operative in Thought (will) • Speech (word) • Act (work)**
    - **Inherently relational**
      - **Internally • Externally**
    - **Always ...**
      - **Selfless • Sacrificing • Serving**
      - **Gracious • Merciful • Patient • Loving • Kind • Forgiving**

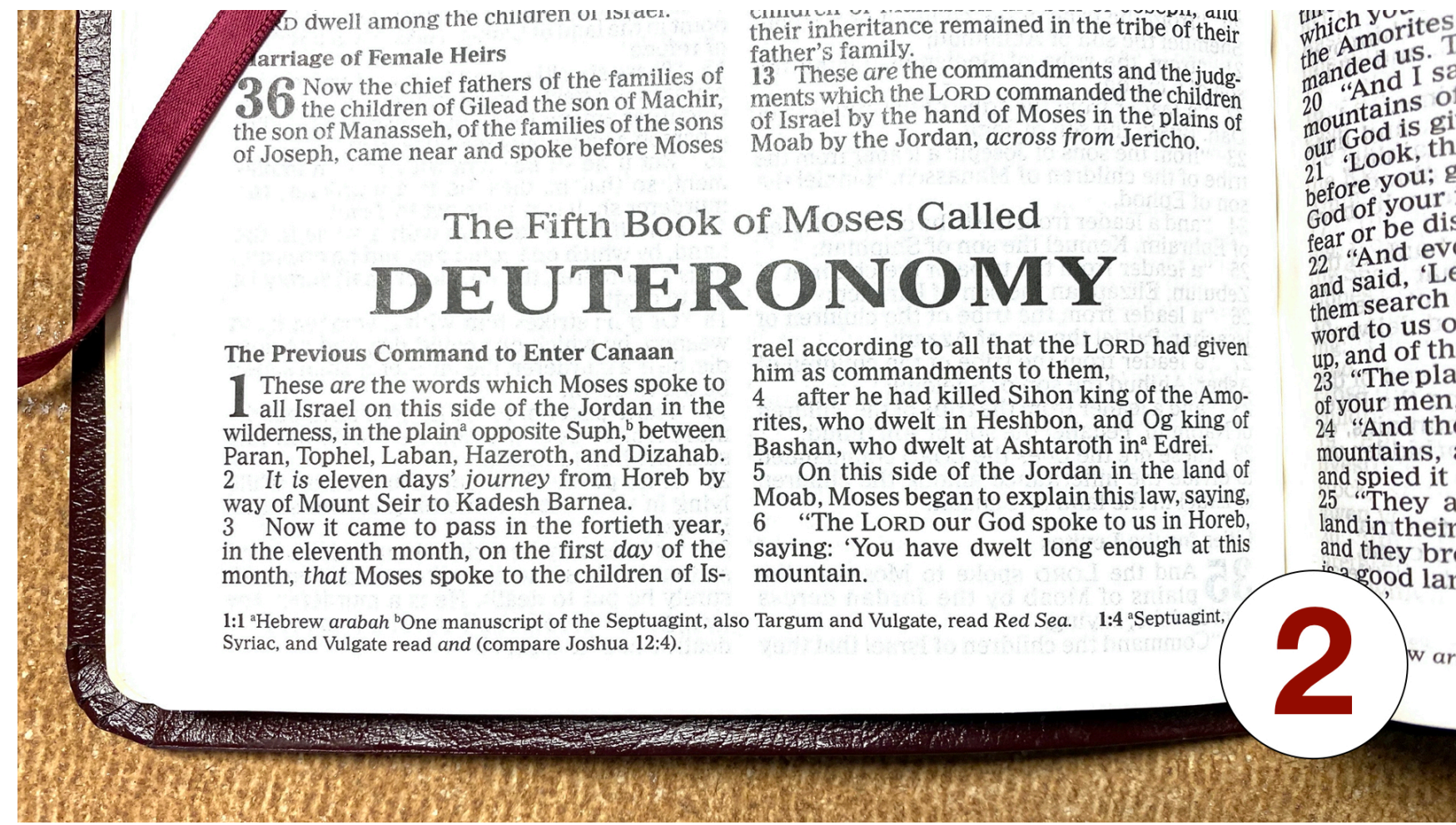


# Lessons From Deuteronomy

---

- **Key Messages - 2 • One World**
  - **Heaven and earth (all creation) testifies on God's behalf**
    - **Deut 4.26, 30.19, 31.19-21, 28, 32.1**
  - **Includes all God's actions witnessed in creation, specifically ...**
    - **Saving/redeeming** Israel from Egyptian bondage
    - **Sustaining** Israel in the wilderness
    - **Guiding** Israel toward Canaan
    - **Fulfilling** the covenant-promise to Abraham (land, seed, blessings)

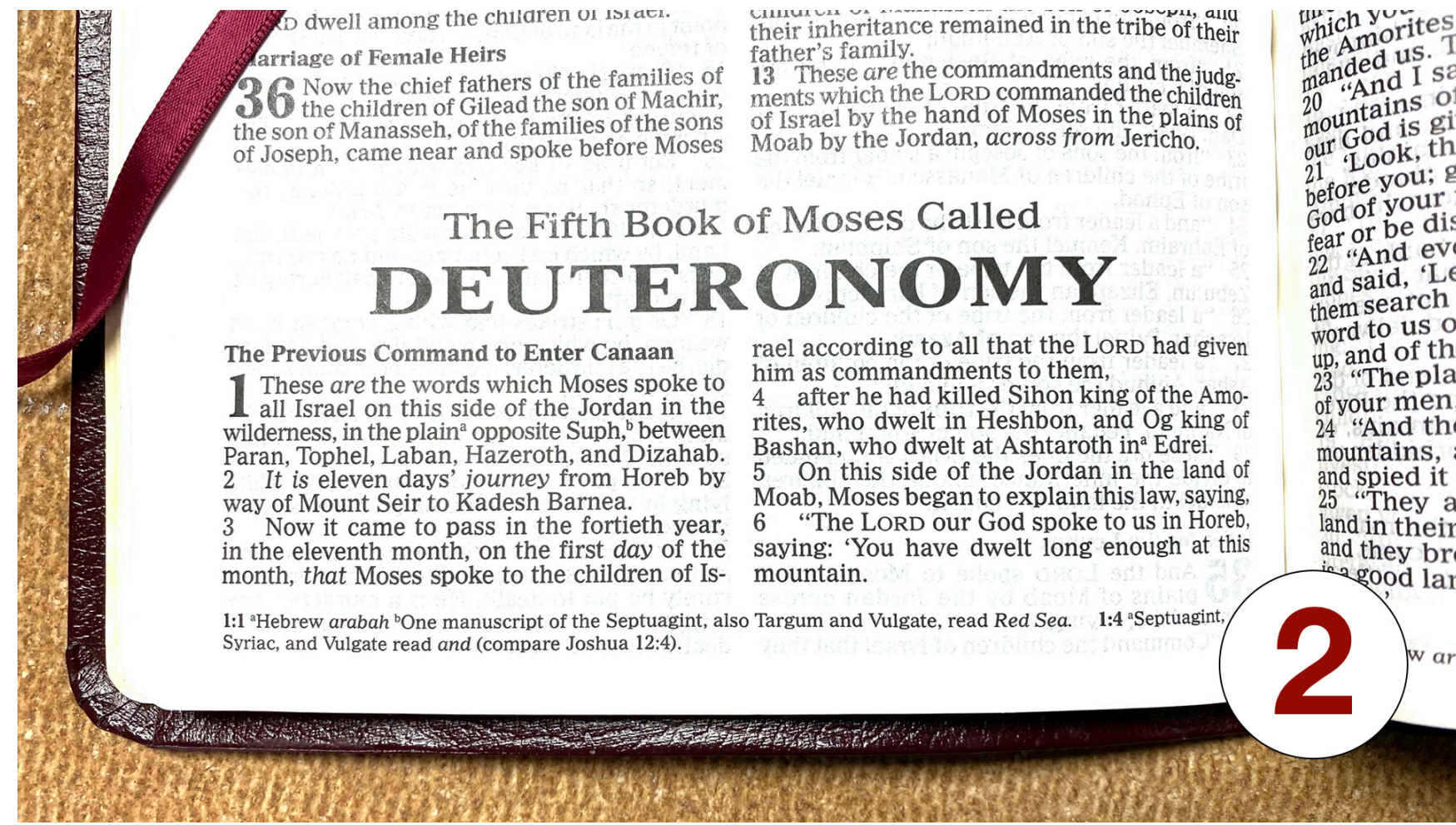




# Lessons From Deuteronomy

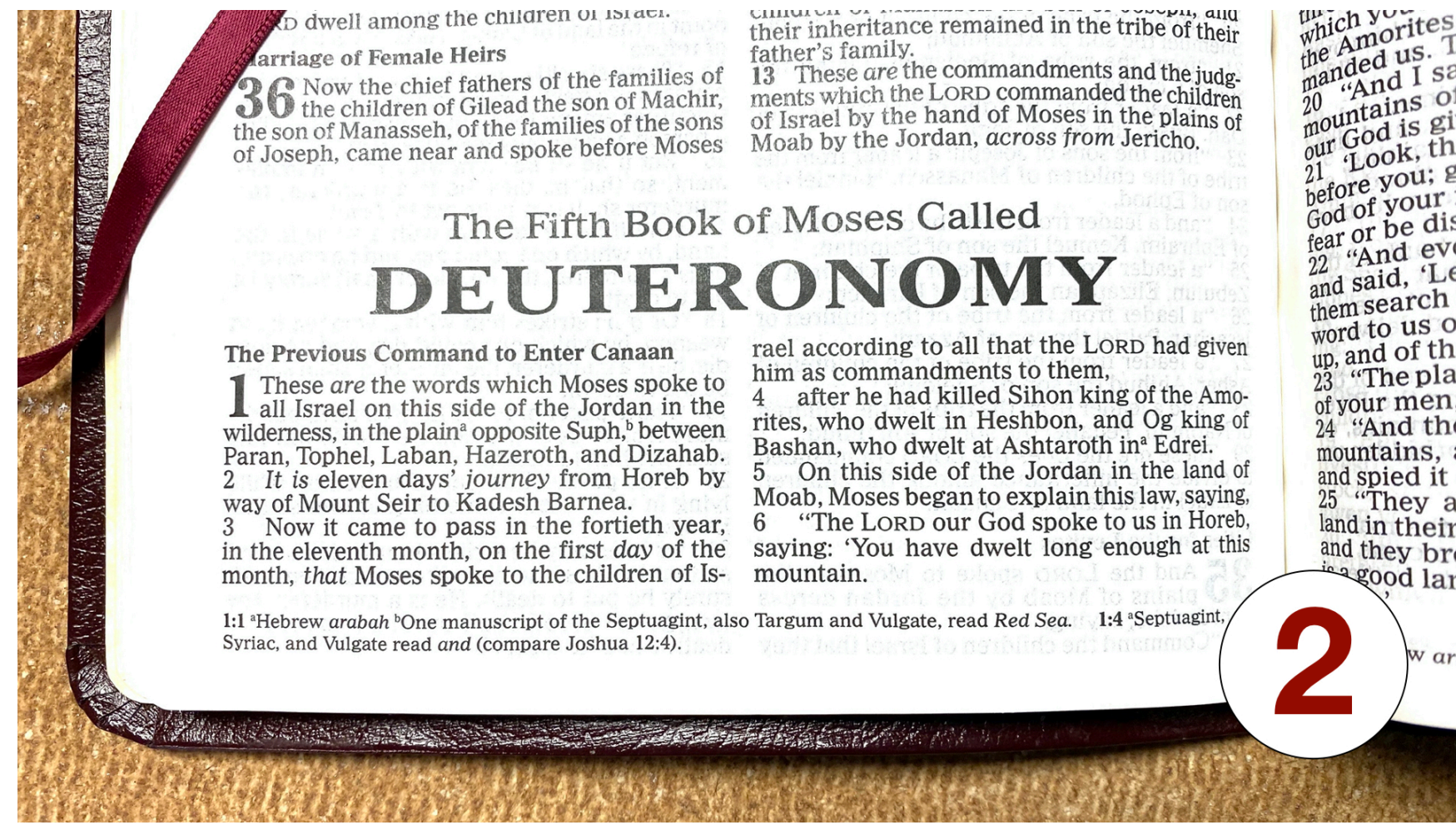
- **Key Messages - 2 • One Word**
  - “And these **words** ...” (6.6)
  - “Which I **command** you ...” (6.6)
  - “You **shall teach** them ...” (6.7)
  - “And **talk** of them ...” (6.7)
  - “You **shall bind** them ...” (6.8)
  - “You **shall write** them ...” (6.9)



# Lessons From Deuteronomy

---

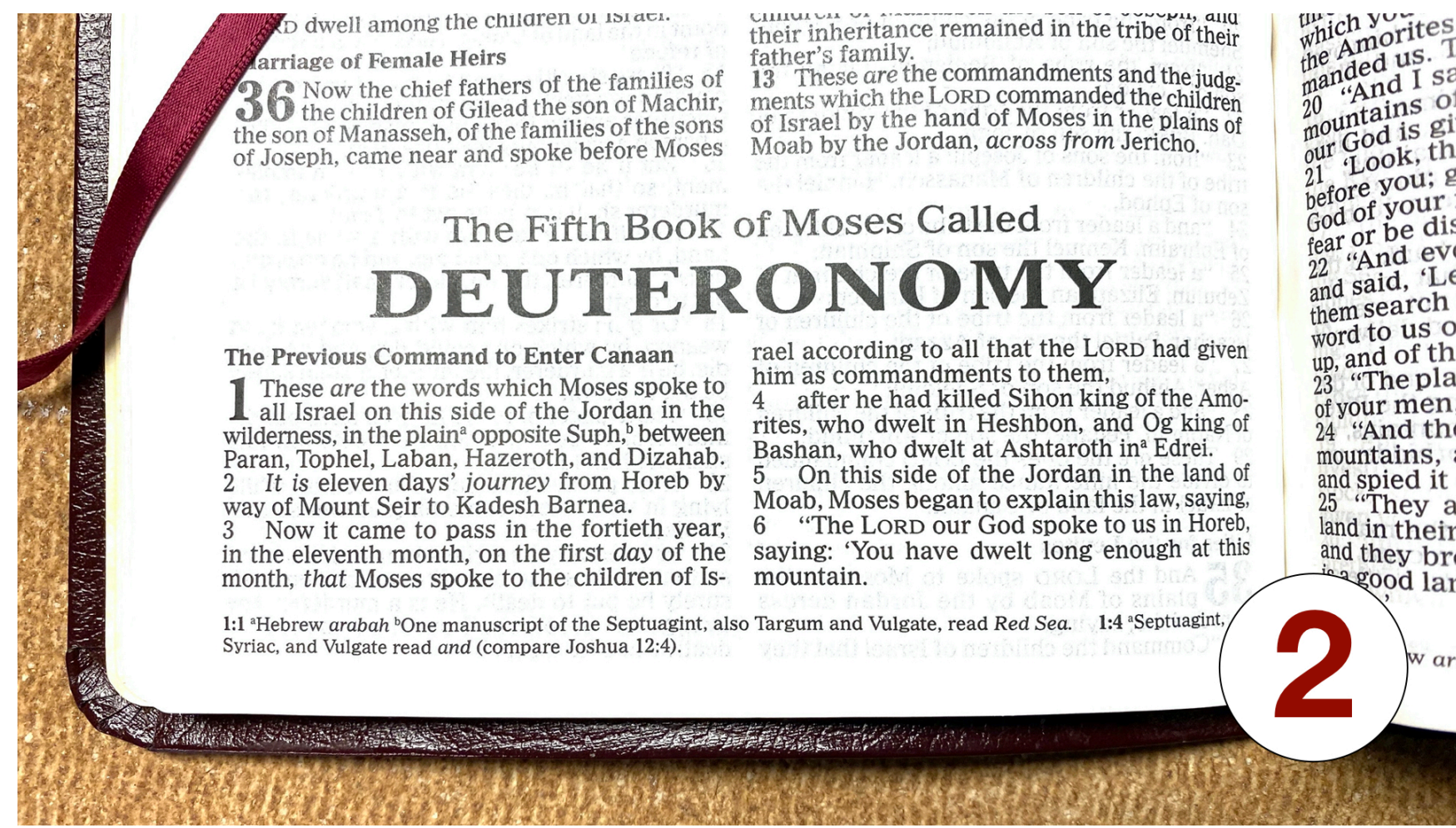
- **Key Messages - 2 • One Way**
  - **command (6.6) • teach (6.7) • talk (6.7) • bind (6.8) • write (6.9)**
    - **“beware, lest you forget ...” (6.12)**
    - **“you shall fear ...” (6.13)**
    - **“you shall ... serve” (6.13) • “you shall ... take oaths in his name” (6.13)**
    - **“you shall not go after other gods” (6.14)**
    - **“you shall not tempt the Lord your God” (6.16)**
    - **“you shall diligently keep the commandments ...” (6.17)**
    - **“you shall do what is right and good ...” (6.18)**

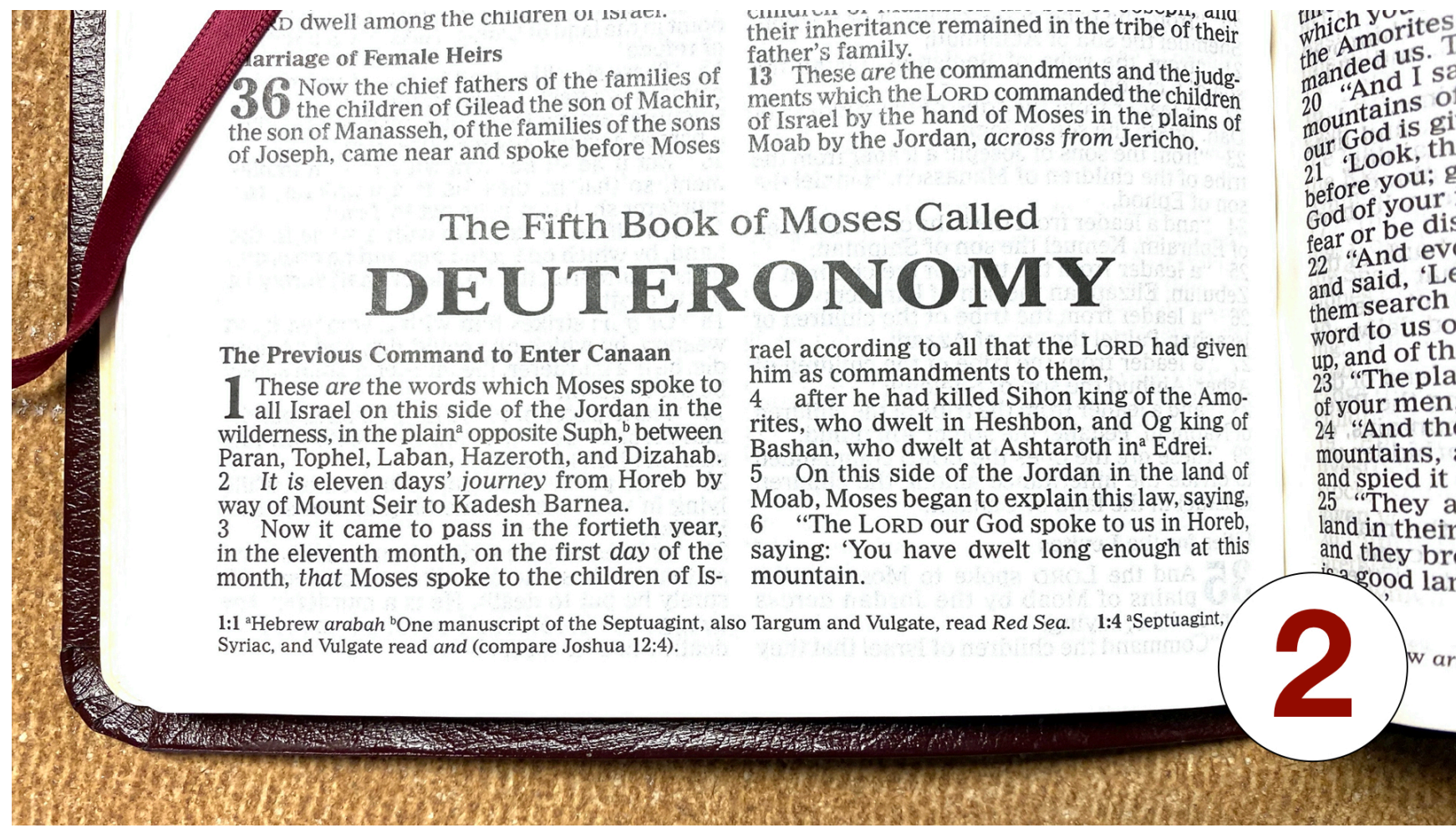
- **Key Messages - 2 • One People (6.20-25)**
  - “what is the **meaning** of the testimonies ...” (6.20)
    - “we **were** slaves ...” (6.21)
    - “the Lord **brought us out of Egypt ...**” (6.21)
    - “the Lord **showed signs and wonders ...**” (6.22)
    - “He **brought us out ... that he might bring us in**” (6.23)



# Lessons From Deuteronomy

---

- **Key Messages - 2 • One People (6.20-25)**
  - “what is the **meaning** of the testimonies ...” (6.20)
  - “the Lord commanded us to **observe** all these statutes ...” (6.24)
    - “**for our good always**” (6.24)
    - “that he might **preserve us alive**” (6.24)
    - “it will be **righteousness** for us” • “if we are **careful to observe**” (6.25)
  - Do **not** be like the nations (7.1ff) • “You are a **holy** people” (7.6)

- **Key Messages - 2 • One People (6.20-25)**
  - That respect what God reveals/says about ...
    - God's existence • God's nature
    - God's world • God's word
    - God's desires • God's expectations
      - **For** God's glory • **Through** our service/sacrifice of holiness/righteousness ...
        - In every aspect of life:
          - In Worship • In Marriage • At work • Showing justice & mercy ...
          - Toward **all** others • At **all** times • Regardless of circumstances
