


What you do not find in Ruth ...



- Common people
 - Jews: Elimelech Naomi Mahlon Chilion Boaz
 - Moabites: Orpah Ruth
- Normal circumstances:
 - Physical: Famine travel harvest (work) community
 - Life events: Marriages death sorrow bitterness friendships

The Prosaic Ruth




What you do find in Ruth ...

- **Common** people demonstrating:
 - Care/kindess/respect: Ruth Bethlehemites Boaz Mara -> Naomi
 - Benevolence: Ruth Boaz Boaz's servants
 - Respect for principle: Ruth Naomi Boaz nearer kinsman
- **Providential** circumstances:

 - Physical: harvest time Boaz's field Boaz's protection Physical/spiritual: Near kinsman • property rights • seed line protection

What you do find in Ruth

- Faith in God: Ruth Naomi Boaz Boaz's servants
 - kinsman witnesses
 townspeople
- New faith in God: Ruth
- Renewed faith in God: Naomi
- Judges versus Ruth:
 - Physical vs spiritual disobedience vs obedience
 - No king in Israel vs the coming king in Israel
 - The coming king in Israel -> the perfect king over Israel/world
