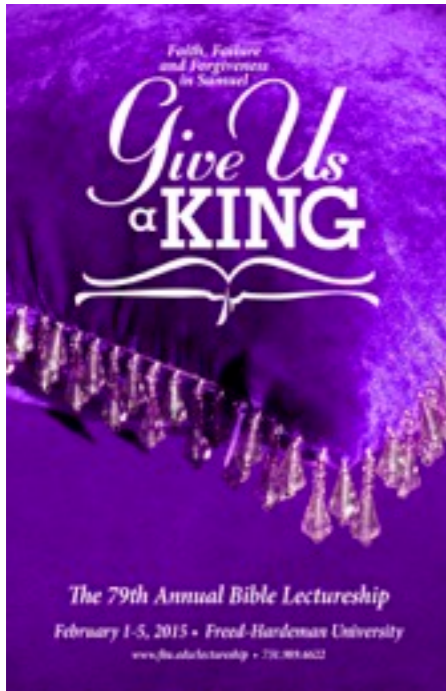

- *Singular Text - Samuel/Kings, Four Kingdoms*
- Multiple vs singular themes/purposes
 - 1 Samuel - Saul ascending/descending
 - 2 Samuel - David ascending/descending

- *Singular Text - Samuel/Kings, Four Kingdoms*
- Multiple vs singular themes/purposes
 - 1 Kings - kingdom divides, Judah alone
 - 2 Kings - kingdoms in captivity, restored

- *Singular Text = Singular Purpose*
- Abrahamic covenant/promise continues
- Reality of sin - Israel now governed by Mosaic law • Promise/law conditional principles of obedience/bless, disobedience/curse

At A Glance

Principles & Character

- David's respect for *anointed*
 - Refused to kill Saul
 - Avenged Saul's death
 - Showed compassion for Saul's family



Second Samuel

At A Glance

Principles & Character

- David's Intent: To Be & Act *Anointed* (23:3)
- Consolidation of kingdom
- Drove out Jebusites • Building projects
- Expanded the borders • Team player

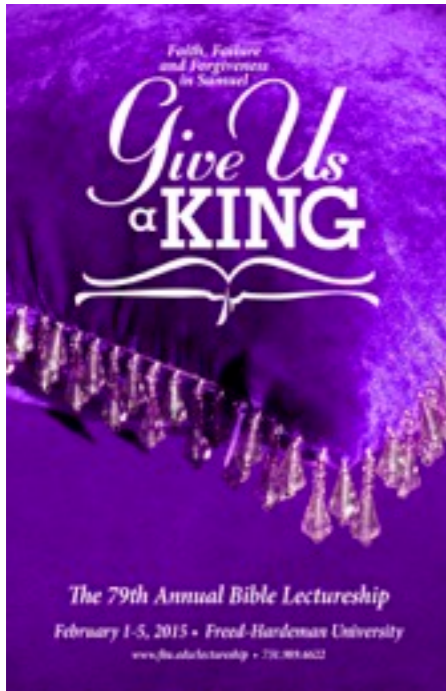

Principles & Character

- David's Intent: To Worship God & Be God's
 - Inquired of God - 5:19
 - David & the ark - 6
 - David & the temple - 8:9; I C 22:1-4; 14-16

Principles & Character

- David's Personal Life: Sin & Confession
 - Achan • *Prodigal* • Saul vs David
 - David & God: rock, fortress, strength, shield, refuge, deliverer, supporter, delight

Redemptive & Messianic

- David's & Christ's genealogy
- David & Christ as anointed
- David's temple & Christ as temple
- David's imperfections • Christ's perfections

Redemptive & Messianic

- David & Christ as shepherd - Ezek 34:23
- David as servant • Christ as David - 37:24ff
- David's prophecy of *resurrection* - Ps 16:10
- David's prophecy of *ascension* - Ps 68: 18

Summary

- David was not perfect, yet God made a covenant with him (2 Sam. 23:5). David's imperfections did not abrogate God's ability to save him. Nor do ours.
