# "Concerning Me"



- I told you this
  - Lk 9.22 Son of man ... suffer rejected killed raised
  - Lk 9.44 Son of man ... about to be betrayed
  - Lk 17.25 "But first He must suffer many things and be rejected by this generation."
  - Lk 18.31-33 "all things ... written by the prophets ... will be accomplished."
  - · Lk 22.37 · "I say ... that this which is written must still be accomplished ..."
  - Acts 1.16, 2.23, 3.18,13.27, 2:23



- The Law of Moses told you this
  - See 2.22–24, 27, 39, 5.14, 10.26, 16.16–17, 29, 31, 20.28, 37, 24.14, 27
  - No specific texts from the law of Moses are cited by Jesus in Luke 24
  - So we do NOT know what he said then
  - We DO know what Luke recorded in part 2, the book of Acts



- The Law of Moses told you this
  - 3.22 A Prophet like me
  - 6.14 Change the customs which Moses delivered
  - 7.31-32 I am the God of your fathers
  - 7.35 A ruler and a deliverer
  - 7.37 A Prophet like me
  - 7.44 Moses ... pattern



- The Law of Moses told you this
  - 13.39 not be justified by the law of Moses
  - 15.21 preach him (Moses) in every city ... every Sabbath
  - 26.22 saying no other things than ... prophets and Moses
  - 28.23 persuading them concerning Jesus from both the Law of Moses and the Prophets



- The Prophets told you this
  - See 1.70, 16.16, 29, 31, 18.31, 24.25, 27, Acts 3.18, 21, 24, 10.43, 24.14
  - No specific texts from the prophets are cited by Jesus in Luke 24
  - So we do NOT know what he said then
  - We DO know what Luke recorded in part 2, the book of Acts



- The Prophets told you this
  - 2.16 the prophet Joel
  - 2.30 being a prophet (David)
  - 3.18 foretold by the mouth of all His prophets
  - 3.21-24 holy prophets, a Prophet, that Prophet, all the prophets, sons of the prophets
  - 7.37 God will raise up for you a Prophet like me ... Him you shall hear
  - 7.42 as it is written in the book of the Prophets
  - 7.52 which of the prophets did your fathers not persecute



- The Prophets told you this
  - 8.28 reading Isaiah the prophet (cf. 8.34)
  - 10.43 to Him all the prophets witness ...
  - 13.15 after reading of the Law and the Prophets ... say on
  - 13.20 Samuel the prophet
  - 13.40 what has been spoken in the prophets
  - 15.15 and with this the words of the prophets agree, just as it is written



- The Prophets told you this
  - 24.14 written in the Law and in the Prophets
  - 26.22 saying no other things than those which the Prophets and Moses...
  - 26.27 King Agrippa, do you believe the prophets? I know that you do believe.
  - 28.23 persuading them concerning Jesus from the Law of Moses and the Prophets
  - 28.25 the Holy Spirit spoke rightly through Isaiah the prophet ...



- The Psalms told you this
  - See "Now David himself said in the Book of Psalms: "The LORD said to my Lord, 'Sit at My right hand, ..." (Lk 20.42)
  - No specific texts from the Psalms are cited by Jesus in Luke 24
  - So we do NOT know what he said then
  - We DO know what Luke recorded in part 2, the book of Acts



- The Psalms told you this
  - 13.3 God has fulfilled this for us their children, in that He has raised up Jesus. As it is also written in the **second Psalm**:
    - "You are My Son,
    - Today I have begotten You.'
  - 13.35 Therefore He also says in another Psalm:
    - "You will not allow Your Holy One to see corruption."



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- The Psalms told you this
  - 2.30 Ps 132.11
  - 2.31 Ps 16.10
  - 2.34-35 Ps 110.1
  - •4.11 Ps 118.22
  - **4.25-26** Ps 2.1-2
  - **13.22** Ps 89.20, 132.11
  - **13.35** Ps 16.10

### Law · Prophets · Psalms



- Jesus opened their understanding
  - Opened "b. fig., ears ... Mk 7:34, 35 v.l. eyes (=make understanding possible, as Gen 3:5, 7; 4 Km 6:17) Lk 24:31; heart (=enable someone to perceive, ...) Ac 16:14; mind Lk 24:45 (cp. Hos 2:17)." [BDAG]
  - Opened "2. explain, interpret ... the Scriptures Lk 24:32; Ac 17:3 ..." [BDAG]
  - Opened involves preparation (mechanics/method) and the reality (carrying out)
  - Acts 17.3 "explaining and demonstrating (proving) that the Christ had to suffer ..."



- That they might comprehend the Scriptures
  - Comprehend "to have an intelligent grasp of someth. that challenges one's thinking or practice, understand, comprehend"
    - Mt 13.51 "Jesus said to them, "Have you understood all these things?" They said to Him, "Yes, Lord." Lk 2.50 "But they did not understand the statement which He spoke to them." Lk 18.34 "But they understood none of these things; this saying was hidden from them, and they did not know the things which were spoken."



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But you must continue in the things which you have learned and been assured of, knowing from whom you have learned them, and that from childhood you have known the Holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith which is in Christ Jesus.
