"Love" in the NT

- Defines who God is
 what God does
 - God is love 1 Jn 4.8 God loves the world Jn 3.16
- Defines who we are what we do
 - We are loved by God We love one another 1 Jn 4.11



"Love" in the NT

- verb/love-loved 143 noun/love 116 noun/beloved 61
 - used negatively
 - Pharisees loved the best seats in the synagogue Lk 11.43
 - Pharisees loved the praise of men Jn 12.43
 - Mankind loves darkness Jn 3.19
 - Demas **loved** the world 2 Tim 4.10
 - We are cautioned not to love the world 1 Jn 2.15



"Love" in the NT

- verb/love-loved 143 noun/love 116 noun/beloved 61
 - used positively
 - "the NT never uses the noun $\alpha\gamma\alpha\pi\eta$ in negative contexts" (NIDNTTE, 1.108)
 - "the love of God" = "God's love for us" subjective
 - "the love of God" = "our love for God" objective
 - includes/demands our love for each other
 - includes/demands our love for all ... even our enemies



How love in John moves from ...

- God loves the world
- Man loves the world
- The Father loves the Son
- The Son loves the Father
- Man loves the Father and the Son
- Jesus loves mankind -> Jesus loves me
- Jesus taught the disciples to love
- The Father loves me ... you ... all souls



How love in John moves¹

- God loved/loves the world
 - "For God so **loved** the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life." **3:16**
 - God's love reaches out
 - God's love draws in
 - See
 - Rom 5.8 Eph 2.4 2 Th 2.16 1 Jn 3.1 1 Jn 4.9 1 Jn 4.10



How love in John moves²

- Man loved/loves the world
 - 3.19 for darkness
 - 12.25* for our own life
 - 12.43 for the praise of men
 - 15.19* you are not loved by the world because you are not of the world



How love in John moves³

- The Father loved/loves the Son
 - 3.35 the Father loves the Son and gave all things into his hand
 - 5.20* the Father loves the Son and gave all things into his hand
 - 10.17 the Father loves the Son because he was willing to give his life
 - 15.9 the Father loved me (the Son)
 - 17.24 the Father loved the Son before the foundation of the world
 - 17.26 the Father loved the Son



How love in John moves⁴ ...

- The Son loved/loves the Father
 - 14.31 that the world may know that Christ loved the Father ...
 - 17.24 the Son loved the Father before the foundation of the world (implicit)
 - 17.26 the Son loved the Father (implicit)



How love in John moves^{5a} ...

- Man loved/loves the Father and the Son
 - Negative
 - 5.42 does **not** exist (the love of God is not in you)
 - 8.42 does not exist (if you were of your Father, i.e. God, you would love me)
 - Positive
 - 14.15 if we love Christ, we will keep his commandments
 - 14.21 having/keeping Christ's commandments ...
 - shows love for Christ
 - those who do so are loved by the Father
 and thus loved by Christ



How love in John moves^{5b} ...

- Man loved/loves the Father and the Son
 - Negative
 - 14.24 those who do not love Christ do not keep his words
 - the words are not only Christ's
 they are God's words

Positive

- 14.23 if we love Christ, he will keep his words
 - and the Father will love him/come to him
 the Son will abide with him
- 14.28 if the apostles loved Christ -> rejoice that he returned to the Father
- 16.27* you have loved me (2x)



How love in John moves^{6a} ...

- Jesus loved/loves mankind
 Jesus loves me
 - 11.3*, 36* for Lazarus
 - 11.5 for Martha, Mary and Lazarus
 - 13.1 for his own, disciples/apostles, to the end (2x)
 - 13.23, 19.26. 20.2*, 21.7 disciple whom Jesus loved
 - 15.9 **as** the Father **loved** Christ, so Christ **loved** the apostles, therefore keep my commandments



How love in John moves^{6b} ...

- Jesus loved/loves mankind
 Jesus loves me
 - 15.13 no greater love than to lay down your life for one's friends
 - 17.26 the Son's love may be in the disciple's
 - 21.15*, 16*, 17* Jesus questioned Peter about his love for the Christ



How love in John moves^{7a} ...

- Jesus taught the disciples to love one another ...
 - 13.34 love one another, as I have loved you, love one another
 - 13.35 world will recognize you as my disciples if you love one another
 - 15.9 continue in my, Christ's, love
 - 15.10 if you keep my commandments, you/apostles, abide in my/Christ's love
 - 15.12 love one another, as I loved you



How love in John moves^{7b} ...

- Jesus taught the disciples to love one another ...
 - 15.13 no greater love than to lay down life for one's friends
 - 15.17 we are commanded to love one another
 - 17.26 the love of God & Christ in them teaches/compels the disciples to love
 - 21.15*, 16*, 17* Peter affirmed his love* for the Christ



How love in John moves⁸

- God the Father loves you/me/all
 - 14.21 God loves you because you love me and keep my commandments
 - 16.27* (2x) God loves you because you loved me & believed I came from God
 - 17.23 God loves you as he loves me
 - 17.26 the Father's love may be in the disciples
 - 3.16 God's love for all



How much does God and Christ love me?

- God loves Christ
- Christ loves God
- God loves those who love Christ
- Christ loves disciples as God loved Him
- · God loves disciples as he loved Christ
- God loves all Christians as he loved disciples
- God loves all souls as he loved Christ



Infinite love can not be diminished!
